Expert Tips

- Always try before you buy: visit a retailer to test-fit the seat in your car, as not all seats fit all vehicles.
- Keep your child rear-facing until at least 15 months (i-Size minimum) but ideally until 4 years for maximum safety.
- Check the seat's expiry date: most car seats have a lifespan of 6-10 years from manufacture due to material degradation.
- Register your car seat with the manufacturer to receive safety recall notifications.
- Avoid secondhand seats unless you know the full history (no accidents, all parts present, not expired).
- Use the 'pinch test' to ensure harness is snug: you should not be able to pinch any slack at the shoulder.
- For rear-facing infants, never place the seat in front of an active airbag; deactivate it or use the back seat.
- Clean the seat only according to manufacturer instructions; harsh chemicals can weaken harness webbing.
- Consider a swivel seat if you have a small car or back problems – it makes loading and unloading much easier.
- Look for seats with side-impact protection and energy-absorbing materials for enhanced safety.
