- During the healing phase (osseointegration), avoid putting pressure on implants; stick to soft foods and use a temporary denture if needed.
- Clean around implant attachments daily with a water flosser and interdental brushes to prevent peri-implantitis, the leading cause of late implant failure.
- Attend annual implant maintenance check-ups, even if nothing feels wrong, to monitor bone levels and attachment wear.
- Ask your dentist about the warranty on implants and the denture prosthesis, and what aftercare package is included in the initial fee.
