Expert Tips

- Clean or replace air filters every 1-3 months to maintain airflow and efficiency

- Monitor your energy bills monthly; a sudden spike often indicates a system fault
- Set your heat pump to a consistent temperature rather than frequently adjusting it, which can increase energy use
- Bleed radiators and check system pressure if you notice cold spots
- Install a smart thermostat to optimise heating schedules based on your daily routine
- Check your home's insulation before installing a heat pump; poor insulation undermines performance
- Familiarise yourself with the manufacturer's error codes to troubleshoot minor issues before calling an engineer
- Take advantage of the Boiler Upgrade Scheme early, as funding may be limited each year
